

ASC Executive Committee Nomination Form

The Associated Student Council (ASC) is the student government organization at AES. ASC consists of two main components: the Executive Committee (EC) and four Class Councils (CC). The EC has members from all grades in the high school and focuses on school policies and the annual Fall Fiesta, while Class Councils focus on their grade, events, dances, and spirit.

This form is for any member of the student body who is planning to run for office in the upcoming ASC Executive Committee Elections. Any current 8th, 9th, 10th, or 11th grader who will return to AES for the following school year is eligible to run, and must get nominations from students in their grade level of the MS and one of their current teachers (see reverse).

If you run for this position and are not elected, you may then choose to run for a Class Council representative position.

Requirements for Candidates

 - This form (reverse), including nominating, candidate, and parent signatures.
 - Also submit electronically via email the following to **Mr. Webster (jwebster@aes.ac.in)**:
 - o Campaign picture (head and shoulders)
 - o Description of why you should be elected (up to 100 words).
 - Ideas:
 - Why do you want to run for ASC? What would you plan to do if you were elected? You should understand the roles of EC and CC, so that you have a sense of what is appropriate and practical.
 - What would make AES better for students and how could you impact that?
 - Discuss your credibility as a candidate: what relevant experiences do you have and/or what things about you make you a good candidate?
2. Present a speech to the grade 8 on April 19 during advisory time

Requirements if Elected

- Attend weekly Executive Committee meetings
- Plan and participate in ASC activities, in particular Fall Fiesta
- Participate in AES School Board and committee meetings
- Attend an ASC leadership retreat on a Saturday in August (TBA)
- Attend AES strategic retreats as necessary
